Dear Residents of Hatfield Broad Oak Parish

You will, hopefully, have seen from our Parish Council Planning News Sheet that Uttlesford District Council are producing a new Local Plan, which once made, will help to shape the future of our District for the next 18 years.

In conjunction with this process, Hatfield Broad Oak Parish Council has voted to produce a Neighbourhood Plan for our Parish, enabling decisions by Uttlesford, such as whether, or not to grant planning permission in future, to be strongly influenced by our local needs.

It is the Parish Council's duty to ensure that the policies introduced in this new Neighbourhood Plan comply with the majority wishes of our residents and, it is for that reason, we need to identify what concerns you and what you would like to see in the future.




